EACH DAY OF THE COUNTDOWN, WSET-TV AIRED AN ANIMATED COUNTDOWN CLOCK GRAPHIC MULTIPLE TIMES AS WELL AS COUNTDOWN ID'S FROM ABC.

<p>Comments:</p> <p>DURING THIS QUARTER, WSET-TV CONTINUED ITS EDUCATION PROGRAM LAUNCHED ON JANUARY 22, 2008 TITLED "DTV QUESTIONS." WE CONTINUED AIRING PSA'S ENCOURAGING VIEWERS TO SEND US THEIR QUESTIONS ABOUT DIGITAL TELEVISION SO WE CAN ANSWER THEM. WE ASKED THEM TO SEND THEIR QUESTIONS VIA REGULAR MAIL, EMAIL AT DTVQUESTIONS@WSET.COM, OR TO CALL OUR "DTV QUESTIONS" DEDICATED PHONE LINE AVAILABLE TO RECEIVE THEIR MESSAGES 24/7. WE TOLD THEM THAT THEIR QUESTIONS WOULD BE ANSWERED OVER THE COMING MONTHS IN OUR NEWS STORIES, ON OUR WEB SITE, AND THROUGH PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS (PSA'S).</p> <p>EACH MONDAY DURING THE QUARTER WE CONTINUED TO ADDRESS ONE OR MORE OF THOSE QUESTIONS IN A NEWS STORY AIRING IN ALL OF OUR LOCAL NEWS SHOWS - "GOOD MORNING VIRGINIA" (5:30-7:00 A.M.), "ABC13 NEWS MIDDAY," "ABC13 NEWS AT 6:00 P.M.," "ABC13 NEWS AT 7:00 P.M." ON OUR MAIN STATION PHONE LINE, WE RECEIVED APPROXIMATELY ANOTHER 325 CALLS DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS IN THIS QUARTER, FOR A TOTAL OF 1,062 CALLS DURING THE QUARTER. THIS BRINGS OUR TOTAL NUMBER OF CALLS TO APPROXIMATELY 3,668 SINCE THIS PROGRAM BEGAN.</p> <p>TO SUPPLEMENT THE NEWS STORIES, A PSA AIRED THROUGHOUT EACH WEEK REPORTING ON THE ANSWER TO THE QUESTION OF THAT WEEK. THIS PSA REMINDED VIEWERS TO WATCH THE NEXT MONDAY'S NEWSCASTS FOR THE ANSWER TO THE NEXT QUESTION AND DIRECTED VIEWERS TO OUR WEB SITE.</p> <p>WSET-TV PARTICIPATED IN "SOFT TESTS" ON JANUARY 6 (STATEWIDE) DURING ITS 6:30-7:00 A.M. NEWSCAST, ON JANUARY 12 DURING ITS 7:00-7:30 P.M. NEWSCAST, ON JANUARY 13 DURING ITS 6:00-6:30 P.M. NEWSCAST, ON JANUARY 15 (STATEWIDE) DURING ITS 6:00-6:30 P.M. NEWSCAST, AND ON JANUARY 21 (STATEWIDE) DURING ITS 11:00-11:30 P.M. NEWSCAST. WSET-TV STAFF MEMBERS WERE AVAILABLE TO ANSWER THE PHONE CALLS OF VIEWERS. IN ADDITION, SOME VIEWERS LEFT THEIR QUESTIONS ON OUR "DTV QUESTIONS" DEDICATED PHONE LINE DURING THE TESTS. WE PROMOTED THE TESTS WITH SPECIALLY PRODUCED PSA'S AND DURING OUR NEWSCASTS FOR SEVERAL DAYS PRIOR TO THE TESTS. THE PSA'S FOR THE VARIOUS TESTS AIRED APPROXIMATELY 92 TIMES IN JANUARY PRIOR TO THE TESTS.</p> <p>DURING THIS QUARTER WE CONTINUED BRANDING OUR ANALOG AND DIGITAL CHANNELS WITH "BUGS" IN THE LOWER RIGHT ONE-THIRD OF THE SCREEN. WE AIRED PSA'S TELLING VIEWERS HOW TO USE THOSE BUGS TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE READY FOR THE TRANSITION DATE. IF THEY SEE THE WORD "ANALOG," THEN THEY ARE RECEIVING THE ANALOG SIGNAL AND NEED TO TAKE STEPS TO MAKE SURE THEY ARE READY FOR THE ANALOG SHUTDOWN. IF THEY SEE THE WORD "DIGITAL," THEN THEY ARE READY FOR THE TRANSITION DATE. TO FURTHER ALERT OUR VIEWERS ABOUT THE FEBRUARY 17 TRANSITION DATE, WE MADE OUR ANALOG BUG TWICE THE ORIGINAL SIZE ON JANUARY 2. OUR ANALOG BUG WAS CHANGED TO YELLOW ON JANUARY 15, CHANGED TO LARGER YELLOW ON FEBRUARY 1, AND WAS</p>	

SCHEDULED TO CHANGE TO RED ON FEBRUARY 15 (BEFORE THE TRANSITION DATE WAS CHANGED TO JUNE 12). ON FEBRUARY 9, OUR DIGITAL BUG WAS TAKEN OFF THE AIR COMPLETELY. THE ANALOG BUG REMAINED ON THE AIR THROUGHOUT THE QUARTER.

 AS THE NEWS STORIES ARE COMPLETED EACH WEEK, BOTH THE TRANSCRIPTS AND VIDEOS OF THE NEWS STORIES ARE POSTED ON OUR WEB SITE. WE HAVE A BOX ON OUR HOME PAGE THAT TAKES VIEWERS DIRECTLY TO THE LIST OF QUESTIONS AT A SECTION TITLED "EVERYTHING YOU EVER WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT DTV." THEY CAN THEN VIEW THE QUESTIONS AS WELL AS THE NEWS TRANSCRIPTS AND VIDEOS. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS THAT WSET-TV WILL COVER THROUGHOUT THE CAMPAIGN ARE ALREADY POSTED AT THIS LOCATION ON OUR WEB SITE. AS EACH MONDAY'S NEWS STORY IS COMPLETED AND ANOTHER QUESTION IS ANSWERED ON AIR, A LINK IS ADDED TO THE CORRESPONDING NEWS TRANSCRIPT AND VIDEO. TRANSCRIPTS AND VIDEOS FOR ALL NEWS STORIES WILL REMAIN POSTED ON OUR WEB SITE THROUGH THE END OF THE CAMPAIGN IN JUNE 2009. Speaking Engagements

 ON JANUARY 15, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS AND WEB SERVICES JEFF TAYLOR AND RECEPTIONIST/CUSTOMER SUPPORT REPRESENTATIVE LANA BREWER SPOKE TO A GROUP OF RESIDENTS AT VALLEY VIEW RETIREMENT COMMUNITY IN LYNCHBURG. THEY SET UP A CONVERTER BOX AND ANTENNA FOR RESIDENTS TO VIEW, ALONG WITH PACKETS, BROCHURES, AND COLOR HANDOUTS. JEFF SPOKE FOR 30 MINUTES ON THE HISTORY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND HOW FAR WE HAVE ADVANCED IN TELEVISION. HE EXPLAINED DIGITAL TELEVISION AND TALKED ABOUT ITS SIGNALS AND HOW THEY WORK. HE DISCUSSED THE USE AND NEED FOR ANTENNAS IF THEY USE THE CONVERTER BOXES AND HELPED THEM UNDERSTAND THE CURRENT SITUATION WITH THE COUPON PROGRAM (FUNDS HAD BEEN DEPLETED AT THAT TIME). HE ALSO DISCUSSED CABLE AND HOW IT WORKS. HE EXPLAINED THAT THOSE WHO HAVE CABLE HAVE NO WORRIES AND DO NOT NEED A CONVERTER BOX. HE ALLOWED TIME AT THE END OF HIS DISCUSSION FOR QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS. THE RESIDENTS HAD MANY QUESTIONS REGARDING WHAT THEY HAD, WHAT THEY NEEDED, AND HOW TO GET WHAT THEY NEEDED. THE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

PACKET THAT INCLUDED THE FACILITY COUPON APPLICATION WAS DISTRIBUTED. LANA INSTRUCTED THE STAFF ABOUT THE APPLICATION AND MADE THEM AWARE OF THE CURRENT STATUS OF COUPON FUNDING. SOME BROCHURES AND HANDOUTS WERE LEFT FOR THOSE WHO WERE NOT ABLE TO ATTEND. TIME WAS ALSO SPENT WITH THE MAINTENANCE STAFF TALKING ABOUT CONNECTING CONVERTER BOXES TO THEIR MAIN ANTENNA, THE PROBLEMS THEY MAY ENCOUNTER, AND SUGGESTIONS ON HOW TO BYPASS THEM.

WSET-TV WILL BE PROVIDING INFORMATION AT COMMUNITY EVENTS THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD OF OUR CAMPAIGN.

ON JANUARY 24, WSET-TV WAS THE GAME SPONSOR FOR TWO LIBERTY UNIVERSITY BASKETBALL GAMES IN LYNCHBURG - A WOMEN'S GAME AT 2:00 P.M. AND A MEN'S GAME AT 7:00 P.M. AT BOTH GAMES ON THE FOUR BIG SCREENS IN THE VINES CENTER, WSET-TV MESSAGES WERE DISPLAYED. ONE OF THOSE MESSAGES CONCERNED THE UPCOMING DTV TRANSITION AND STATED, "ANALOG TELEVISION BROADCASTING ENDS FEBRUARY 17, 2009 - VISIT WSET.COM - KEY WORD 'DTV' OR CALL 888-DTV-2009 FOR DETAILS." MESSAGES WERE ROTATED, BEGAN PRIOR TO THE GAME, AND WERE SHOWN DURING ALL TIME-OUT PERIODS, HALF-TIME, ETC. THE DTV MESSAGE APPEARED AT LEAST 20 TIMES IN EACH GAME FOR A TOTAL OF 40-50 TIMES IN THE TWO GAMES. THE COMBINED ATTENDANCE OF THESE TWO GAMES WAS 8,248.

ON FEBRUARY 24, HUMAN RESOURCES DIRECTOR JENNY MARSHALL AND NEWS DIRECTOR BILL FOY ATTENDED THE INTERN/CAREER FAIR CAREER PREMIERE AT THE SALEM CIVIC CENTER IN SALEM. SOME OF THE SCHOOLS REPRESENTED WERE LIBERTY UNIVERSITY, RADFORD UNIVERSITY, AVERETT UNIVERSITY, FERRUM COLLEGE, AND BRIDGEWATER COLLEGE. THE DTV BANNER WAS DISPLAYED AND DTV INFORMATION WAS MADE AVAILABLE TO ATTENDEES.

ON MARCH 3-4, ACCOUNT EXECUTIVE RICHARD BENNETT, SALES MANAGER LINDA OTTINGER, AND ACCOUNT EXECUTIVE LUANNE LONG PARTICIPATED IN FAST TRACK 2009 IN MARTINSVILLE. BOOTH SET-UP INCLUDED THREE PULL-UP DISPLAY BANNERS (ONE EACH FOR DTV, RTN, AND WSET-TV INFORMATION). VARIOUS MARKETING HANDOUTS WERE PROVIDED ALONG WITH A DTV BROCHURE AND DTV Q&A PACKETS. THERE WERE 139 VENDORS ATTENDING THE SHOW WITH ESTIMATED ATTENDANCE ON MARCH 3 OF 4,500 AND MARCH 4 OF 2,000. THIS SHOW IS EXTREMELY POPULAR IN THE MARKET NOT JUST FOR BUSINESSES AND VENDORS, BUT ALSO FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC. A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF PEOPLE SPECIFICALLY ON THE SECOND NIGHT HAD QUESTIONS REGARDING THE DTV TRANSITION. THEY WERE GIVEN BOTH THE BROCHURE AND Q&A PACKETS FOR REFERENCE IF INTERESTED. SEVERAL COMMON QUESTIONS/THEMES CAME UP FROM THE AREA THAT OVERLAPS WITH NORTH CAROLINA. SOME PEOPLE WERE RECEIVING OUR DIGITAL SIGNAL AND POSSIBLY NOT RECEIVING OTHER STATIONS IN OUR MARKET. MOST HAD CONVERTER BOXES, BUT SEEMED TO HAVE TROUBLE GETTING THE DIGITAL SIGNALS OF ALL STATIONS.

ON MARCH 10, WSET-TV PARTICIPATED IN THE LYNCHBURG REGIONAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE TRADE SHOW IN LYNCHBURG. WE DESIGNED A BOOTH THAT INCLUDED DTV BROCHURES AND DTV Q&A PACKETS. WE ALSO HAD UPDATED INFORMATION ON THE CONVERTER BOX COUPONS FOR PEOPLE WHO HAD QUESTIONS ABOUT THEM.

WSET-TV IS AN ABC AFFILIATE. ABC HAS BEEN SUPPORTING THE DTV CONSUMER EDUCATION PLAN THROUGH A PSA INITIATIVE SINCE NOVEMBER OF 2007. BEGINNING THE WEEK OF MARCH 31, 2008, ABC STARTED AIRING A WEEKLY SCHEDULE OF CLOSED CAPTIONED DTV CONSUMER EDUCATION PLAN PSA'S AND A WEEKLY SCHEDULE OF IN-PROGRAM LOWER 1/3 SCREEN BANNERS TO LEND SUPPORT TO THE MESSAGE AND DIRECT VIEWERS TO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. ABC'S SUPPORT INCLUDES TWO (2) 30-SECOND DTV CONSUMER EDUCATION PLAN PSA'S PER WEEK AND SIX (6) IN-PROGRAM LOWER 1/3 SCREEN BANNERS EACH WEEK. THIS SUPPORT CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THIS QUARTER.

A DTV DISPLAY CONTINUES TO BE SET UP IN THE WSET-TV LOBBY FEATURING A CONVERTER BOX, RABBIT EARS AND A TELEVISION, ALONG WITH LARGE DTV DISPLAY BANNERS INFORMING STATION VISITORS OF THE UPCOMING CHANGE.
