Dear Mayor Foster,


We enjoyed having you and City Manager Kimball Payne visit LU this week to discuss the relationship between the city and Liberty University.

I'm glad that you and the manager agreed that, in your opinion, Council would support our request to return our zoning to what it was in 1991: B-5 with no cap on enrollment. Bill McRorie has spoken with Walter Erwin and they agree that this change can be accomplished before the election on May 4, 2010. We request that you call a special meeting of Council so that the necessary notices of public meeting can take place prior to a joint meeting of Planning Commission and City Council.
